Tip #1

Recruit volunteers to help take photos

- Engage faculty, staff and students — start by targeting photography students
- Focus on photos of your campus, facilities, events and student activities
- Create an organized photo library you can pull from whenever your site needs refreshed



Tip #2

Keep it candid!

- Avoid staging pictures to ensure your photos aren't forced or unauthentic
- Keep it genuine with shots of people looking at each other, rather than the camera
- Capture your school's spirit by showcasing sincere interactions amongst your people

Tip #3

Take more wide, horizontal shots

- Take landscape photos — these are best for websites, including headers and backgrounds
- Capture wide camera shots for easy scaling on your website and mobile devices
- Create ample space around your composition so you can easily crop and scale them for web use
